- From the driveway turn right and walk past the church and school to the main road, cross over and turn right
- Just after the white house on your left, turn left, signed Bicton House camping & caravan club site. Keep to the left by the hedgerow and walk to the corner
- At the corner the path takes a diagonal line ahead of you across the two fields
- Follow this line into a wooded area. Pass through the copse and cross a ditch to Little Calcott Lane (known locally as Pig Lane, but not marked by either!)

Option 1 – Short Walk, 1.8 miles

Retrace your steps back to Lavender Cottage

Option 2 – Medium Walk, 2.36 miles

- After crossing the ditch, turn left along Little Calcott Lane to the end where it meets Calcott Lane. Turn left and walk to the end of Calcott Lane
- Cross the road and take the unmetalled road to the right of the chiropodist. Pass 'The Hollies' but keep straight and walk down the path to the left of Villa Farm
- At the end of the path, go through kissing gate and walk along the back of the houses to cross another stile at the far side of the field. In this next field, head diagonally to the right, heading towards the bungalow
- At the lane turn left and * walk through the farm steading to a metal gate. Go through the gate and follow the grass lane down to the stream and up into the big field keeping to the straight path uphill and on to another metal gate
- · Go through the gate and turn right and Lavender Cottage is on your left

Option 3 – Long Walk, 2.72 miles

- As short walk to Little Calcott Lane. Walk to the end of Little Calcott Lane and cross
 Calcott Lane into the field opposite
- Head to the opposite side of the field but keep to the left hand side of the field to emerge through a break in the hedge onto Shepherd's Lane. Turn left and walk to the end of Shepherd's Lane to the Four Crosses pub
- Cross the main road and go down Isle Lane at the side of the pub. Walk along until there is an unnamed lane on your left (5 house names on a white sign.)
- Turn left here and walk to the farm steading and continue as for medium walk from *
