## Walk length - 3.3 miles

- From the driveway turn right
- Go through the metal field gate next to 'The Old Vicarage'
- Walk along with the hedge on your left, down the dip across the stream and up to the farm steading
- Go through the gate and keep straight ahead.
- Go through the metal gate on the lane opposite the bungalow
- Walk straight ahead and through the gate at the field end
- Walk diagonally across this field (sometimes docile horses in here) to the house and go through the gate to join Isle Lane.
- Do not go through the estate gates to 'The Isle' but follow the lane ahead passing 'The River House & Rossall Grove'
- Follow the lane to the very end and walk the section of path between two metal gates (large house on your right.)
- Turn right and walk along the path (horses often here) to cross the stile next to the gate
- Follow the signs keeping you to the track to the left (often sheep here) which you follow past a copse on your left, through an arable field and down to cross a bridge across a stream
- Approx 80 paces after the stream, turn right onto a signed bridleway along a field edge following the fence on your right
- Keep on and go through two pairs of metal gates into an open field (usually has sheep in it) and cross the field diagonally following the marker signs that lead towards the white house ahead of you
- On reaching the house, go through the double gates to join Isle Lane
- Cross the lane signed Grove Farm and keep straight ahead to pass through the farm steading to retrace your way home
